Each certificate program is offered virtually two times each year, with each student having the option of meeting for a total of three nights during the week at 2-3 hour intervals (Cohort A) or for one 8 hour session which is offered on a Saturday (Cohort B.)



Upon completing each program level, students will receive an attractive certificate of completion, embossed with the TVMI seal and suitable for framing, along with a folder which features the school logo emblazoned on the front.

Each program level builds on the previous and are designed to be completed in order. For details on prerequisites, please refer to the Course Descriptions section. As stated, each program has two registration options, as shown below.

Please note that an application is not required to complete any certificate or diploma program offered through Tennessee Valley Ministry Institute. Students are permitted to register for any program without engaging in a selective admissions process. However, prior to enrollment, each prospective student should agree to possessing the following minimum requirements:

- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of attending classes
- Feel personally called into a ministry involving pastoral care, counseling, and/or coaching

- Have already obtained a high school diploma or GED prior to the start of the program, OR
- Be able to read, write, and comprehend at the level of a high school graduate

INSTRUCTIONAL INFORMATION



GRADING POLICY

Each student is graded on a Pass or Fail basis. This is weighted and determined upon the following criteria:

• Class Participation (25% of final grade)

Discussion Board (25% of final grade)

• Comprehensive Examination (50% of final grade)

The class participation grade is determined by a student's engagement with the instructor and fellow students, as well as clinical skills practice offered in the Christian Counseling and Life Coaching diploma programs. This features students functioning in the roles of counselor, client, and observer. (Executive Leadership students complete a final project focusing on practical applications of concepts learned.) The comprehensive examination is an online, open-book test featuring both true/false and multiple choice questions. Questions are selected from course quide notes and contain Bible questions and those related to the student's major.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Due to the intensive nature of our program, it is imperative students be present and punctual for all online sessions to graduate. If illness (or another emergency) precludes a student from attending a class, then reasonable accommodations can be provided. Generally, make up classes can be taken at another scheduled offering during the academic year. However, no student will be eligible to receive their certificate and/or diploma until all academic requirements have been fulfilled.

TRANSFER POLICY

Due to the intensive format of our courses, we don't accept transfer credit from other institutions. Graduates receive a continuing education unit for completing the live Christian Counseling course, 2 CEU for online certificates and 8 CEU for diploma programs.

We currently offer online certificate and diploma programs in the disciplines of Christian Counseling and Christian Coaching. We also offer a live certificate program in Christian Counseling which is offered in various cities throughout the Summer. Detailed course descriptions are located on page 16 of the academic catalog. COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

BIBL 101 Survey of the Bible

This course is required for all diploma programs and introduces students to the Holy Bible, equipping them with a sound working understanding of the content, structure, settings, and themes of both Old and New Testaments. It is designed to help students heighten their awareness of the Bible generally, as well as provide insights into the major theological issues it addresses.

CCOU 101 Principles of Christian Counseling I

The first course in Christian Counseling features the following six units: Introduction to Christian Counseling, Counseling Models & Techniques, Legal Issues in Counseling, Ethical Considerations in Counseling, and Individual Client Issues and Treatment I & II. In addition, students will begin clinical skills practice, allowing them to serve in the roles of counselor, client, and observer.

CCOU 102 Principles of Christian Counseling II

This course will introduce the student to counseling diverse populations and features the each of the following units: Marriage & Family Counseling I & II, Counseling Children & Adolescents, Techniques of Group Counseling, and Foundations of Multicultural Counseling. Students will also continue their clinical skills practice during this phase.

CCOU 103 Principles of Christian Counseling III

The advanced portion in Christian counseling introduces helpful information when it comes to beginning and operating a 501(c)3 nonprofit. The units include: Addiction & Recovery Counseling I & II, Clinical Counseling Issues I & II, Integration of Psychology & Theology, and Executive Leadership in Counseling Ministry. Students will conclude their clinical skills training during this course.

EVAN 101 Foundations of Personal Evangelism

This course is required of all diploma program students and is designed to equip the student in the basic skills and principles of sharing the gospel one-on-one with another individual through evangelism, prayer, and discipleship. Particular focus is given to an evangelistic method which utilizes the principle of, "law to the proud and grace to the humble."

LICO 101 Principles of Life Coaching I

This course will introduce the student to the field of professional life coaching from a Christian worldview, with special attention given to various coaching theories, practice, skills, and an overview of the various specialties found within the field. Students will also learn the importance of self-care practices as a professional life coach.

LICO 102 Principles of Life Coaching II

The continuation of this course will further discuss the attributes of professional coaching from a Christian worldview along with client assessment models and an examination of common client issues that the student may encounter as a life coach. Some areas examined include: career coaching, financial coaching, and relationship coaching.

LICO 103 Principles of Life Coaching III

During this final course in life coaching, students will focus on clinical skills practice, taking turns in the roles of client, life coach, and observer. Understanding limitations in establishing client goals is addressed, as is the subject of executive leadership within a life coaching ministry, along with practical information on how to begin your own 501(c)3 nonprofit life coaching ministry.

PSYC 101 General Psychology

A systematic survey of the field of psychology, covering important general principles in the topics of psychological development, sensory processes, perception, motivation, emotion, learning, thinking, intelligence, aptitudes, social problems, consciousness, wellness, memory, personality, research methods, as well as a brief overview into the field of abnormal psychology.

PSYC 102 Developmental Psychology

This course is designed to examine theory and research on human development across the lifespan from conception to death. It will emphasize the physical, cognitive, social, emotional, and cultural variables which influence human development. Various theories concerning stages of development will be addressed.

THEO 101 Systematic Theology

This course is an overview of Bible doctrine which has been designed to introduce the student to each of the major areas of systematic theology, and includes the following: prolegomena, bibliology, theology proper, Christology, pneumatology, angelology, satanology, demonology, soteriology, hamartiology, anthropology, ecclesiology, and eschatology.




• Is there a difference between the online and in-person courses?
